## Half Term - From tomorrow (28th May 2021) onwards - Track and Trace

Schools will continue to play an important role in contact tracing for pupils and staff over half term.

Where pupils or staff attending the school test positive for Covid 19 during the half term holiday, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school (that is after 3pm on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021) school will not be required to take any action. However, where pupils attending the school test positive having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school (that is before 3pm on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021), the school is involved as usual in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation.

KEY INFECTION AND PREVENTION CONTROLS REMAIN IN PLACE as published in the "daily plan". By following these measures we all reduce risks in our setting and create a safer environment.

#### We MUST always:

- 1. Minimise contact with individuals who are unwell by ensuring that those who have coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, or who have someone in their household who does, do not attend school.
- 2. Ensure face coverings are used in recommended circumstances.
- 3. Ensure everyone is advised to clean their hands thoroughly and more often than usual.
- 4. Ensure good respiratory hygiene for everyone by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach
- 5. Maintain enhanced cleaning, including cleaning frequently touched surfaces often using standard products, such as detergents.
- Consider how to minimise contact across the site and maintain social distancing wherever possible.
- 7. Keep occupied spaces well ventilated.
- 8. Ensure individuals wear the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) where necessary.
- 9. Promote and engage in asymptomatic testing, where available.
- 10. Promote and engage with the NHS Test and Trace process.
- 11. Manage and report confirmed cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) amongst the school community.
- 12. Contain any outbreak by following local health protection team advice.
